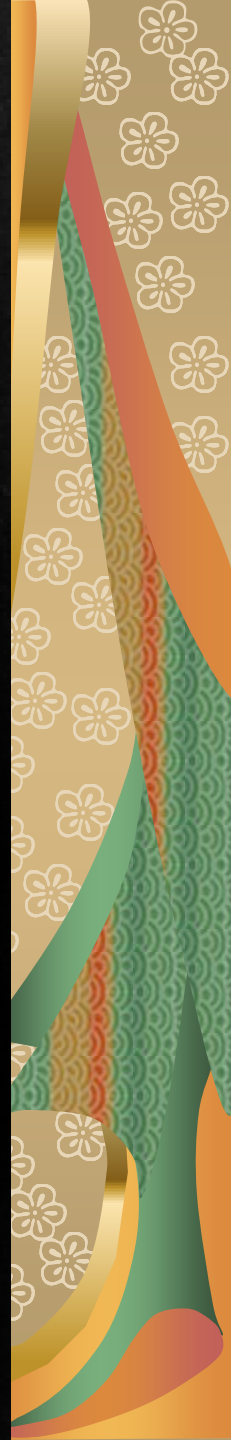
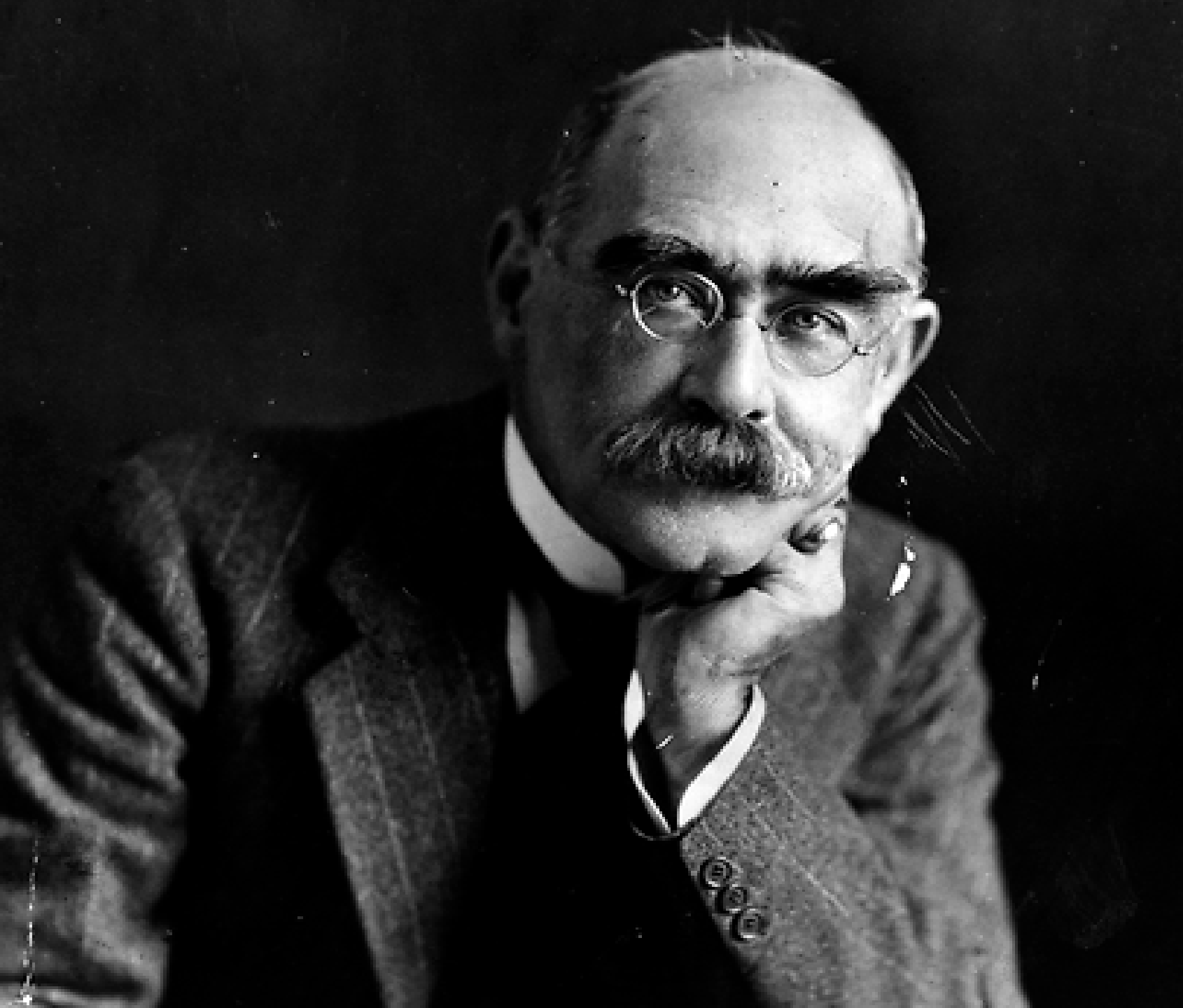

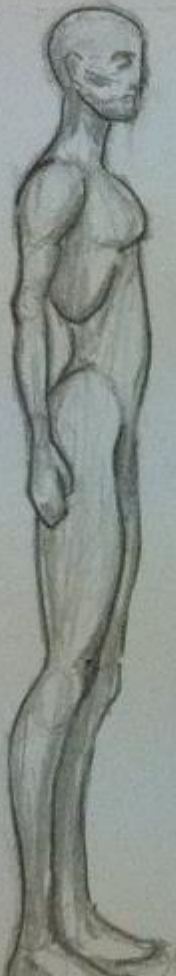


THE CAMEL LIVED IN THE MIDDLE OF
